

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wickersham would move to return the bill for a specific amendment, AM2410. (See pages 2403 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. First off, I guess I should apologize to the body for suggesting that I had boxed in Senator Witek. She didn't vote for the amendment, so if it was a box, I guess it wasn't tightly tied enough, but, at any rate, the amendment that's before us now simply implements the changes that you voted for in three...in the amendment to LB 369; changes the appropriations necessary to fund the unfunded liability, and I would simply ask your support for the amendment. It has also been passed out to you. It is AM2410, if you are concerned about the specific language.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The motion before the body then is the return of LB 369A. Senator Wickersham, do you have closing? Proceed to vote on the motion. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The bill is returned. Senator Wickersham, to open. Senator Wickersham feels his explanation was complete enough. Probably shouldn't put words in your mouth, but I assume that is what the wave means. Any discussion? Seeing none, the question is the adoption of the Wickersham amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. Speaker, I'd move to advance LB 369A to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. LB 384.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 384, Senator Landis, I have AM1817 in front of me, Senator.
