

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: If I could be recognized, I will be withdrawing this motion in just a moment. What we are about to do on LB 384 is to take some provisions occasioned by a recent federal law change and put them into 384. Now when I originally drafted the amendment, I put in two sections, one were the federal law responses, and the second was a controversial provision with respect to the number of branches that you could have in a bank, basically, in Lancaster County. That is a controversial provision, and I have talked to the opponents of that measure, namely, Senators Hall and Lindsay, and I have agreed to drop the controversial provision, which means I have got to disperse. I am going to ask to withdraw this amendment in a moment. I believe the next piece of business will be Senator Hall and Senator Lindsay with their motion, and our understanding is that that will be withdrawn. Then the third piece will be only the changes that are occasioned by recent federal law and the Riegle-Neal Federal Interstate Banking Act. I will give a full and complete explanation when that motion is before us. I'd ask for the withdrawal of this amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Knowing Senator Landis, we know he is a man of his word, he will give us a full and complete explanation I am sure. That amendment is withdrawn. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator, I had a suspension motion from you. Pull?

SPEAKER WITHEM: It is pulled.

CLERK: Senator Lindsay and Hall would move to return the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hall, bracket motion, Senator?

SPEAKER WITHEM: Withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Landis would move to return for 20...AM2385, Mr. President.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Clerk, would you read the number again.
