

but it would be impossible, at this point, to meet that from everything I've been told, so we must allow flexibility, and we're at the beck and call of the federal government at this point as to whether or not we go forward and when we go forward. So this is one of those we can't do much else than this, and I'd ask your support for the motion to return.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. The question is returning the bill to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR HALL: The bill is back to Select File. Senator Wesely, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR WESELY: Again the amendment provides that instead of having the July 1, 1995 cutoff date by which we have to implement Medicaid managed care, we require it by within 45 days after the receipt of the waivers that we've applied for, and we have the E clause attached to this because it has to take effect immediately to head off the problem that we face by not meeting the July 1 deadline. With that, I'd answer any questions, and ask for adoption.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Is there any discussion on the amendment? Seeing none, Senator Wesely waives closing. The question is the adoption of the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SENATOR HALL: The Select File amendment is adopted. Senator Maurstad, on the bill.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to advance LB 693AE to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR HALL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed. Motion carries. The bill is readvanced. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk? Items for the record.
