

SENATOR HALL: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Up towards the top in the new language with reference to the board, it says, one member shall have experience in one of each of the following groups.

SENATOR HALL: Right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: It identifies seven groups.

SENATOR HALL: Right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Can one member have experience in two of the groups and, therefore, meet the qualifications? Or is this intended that one...there shall be one member that has experience in each of those seven areas?

SENATOR HALL: It's intended, Senator Beutler, to have individual members, one, and I think...I guess you could read it either way. It says one member shall have experience in one of each of the following groups. The intent there is to have a representative from each of those seven groups.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, so that when somebody's vacancy comes up you will be filling the licensed attorney's slot or the at-large slot, or...

SENATOR HALL: Or the civil rights slot, correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. On page 39, with respect to the tier 1 investigations and the dismissal of charges pursuant to that procedure,...

SENATOR HALL: Right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...at the first line of (c), requires notification to the complainant as well as to the respondent of the dismissal,...

SENATOR HALL: Uh-huh.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...and then gives a very short period of time for asking for reconsideration. Would you have any objection to some standard language in that original notification...
