

CLERK: No, sir, not at this time.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: We are on the ninth division, which is actually the first of nine divisions. We...Senator Bohlke wanted to pick up the ninth division first. There are no amendments pending to that, so we'll have discussion on that particular portion. Chair recognizes Senator Beutler. There are no further lights. Is there any discussion on this first division, which is division number nine? Chair seeing none would recognize Senator Bohlke to close. Is anyone authorized to close for Senator Bohlke. Actually, Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Yeah, I asked...well, I see Senator Bohlke coming now, but I'd ask for adoption of this amendment.
