

SENATOR WILL: The question is, should the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SENATOR WILL: The house is under call. All unexcused members please report to the Chamber. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Lindsay, you may begin your close, whenever you're ready.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Mr. President. This is the motion to reconsider. We just had a...the last time we were under call had the vote on the Dierks amendment. It was a close vote. We've had a little bit of discussion since then. This is a reconsideration to place that amendment back before us again. The amendment, the Dierks amendment, if it's placed back before us, would delay the implementation of the family cap that's contained in LB 455. As the discussion has gone on, I think quite extensively, the question is whether that policy ought to be in the bill or not. I do not believe that it ought to be in the bill. I think at least with delaying the implementation it gives us an opportunity to see how this policy operates in other states. With that, I would urge that the reconsideration motion be adopted and that subsequently the Dierks amendment be adopted.
