SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Beutler, your light is next. Senator Beutler waives off. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Call the question.

SENATOR WILL: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. The question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on ceasing debate? Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, to cease debate.

SENATOR WILL: Debate has ceased. Senator Dierks, you are recognized to close on your amendment.

SENATOR DIERKS: Mr. President and members of the body, Mr. President, I would like to call the house and...

SENATOR WILL: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay.

SENATOR DIERKS: And I would like to ask for a...

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR WILL: The house is under call. All unexcused senators please report to the floor and record your presence. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Senator Dierks, you are recognized to close.

SENATOR DIERKS: Mr. President, members of the body, I think the closing really isn't necessary because we've touched on all the issues a number of times. I think people have their minds made up what they're going to do about this. I only wish that they would consider very carefully what they're doing for Nebraskans and how they can support Nebraskans with this...with this amendment. And I would ask that the roll call vote be taken in regular order, please.

SENATOR WILL: You've heard the closing. There's still a number
