

are increased by \$30, and so the total loss for the sanctions is probably going to be the balance of that difference. And so I think that's important to realize that in talking about children and the safety of children and if adults are the ones who cause the sanction to take place that when that does happen that actually they do get an increase in food stamps. And, certainly, the person knows the consequences, they know what's going to happen as they've worked along with the caseworker. In order to have that sanction take place, they have to absolutely not cooperate, not agree to do many of the things within the contract. But, most assuredly, what does happen is that that safety net, I think, would be there for children as the extra \$30 in food stamps. I'm opposed to the Crosby amendment.
