

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President, members. Senator Witek was just talking to me about a field trip to the zoo. The question I have is of Senator Wesely with regard to this section. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Senator Wesely, would you respond?

SENATOR WESELY: Sure.

SENATOR HALL: When you look at the E & R amendment, on page 8, where it starts at the top, 68-1702.

SENATOR WESELY: Right.

SENATOR HALL: And now that language does not go away, it's still in statute, is that correct?

SENATOR WESELY: That's right, that's the current...

SENATOR HALL: So we add Section 22 as it's found in the amendment, the Journal, on page 2410, down at the bottom.

SENATOR WESELY: Oh, okay. Right, okay, but all the sections that we passed last year in the law sunset. The roundtable sunsets, and so do all the sections, so that section, 68-1702, and everything else that ties into the roundtable, it just goes away on July 1, so...

SENATOR HALL: Why are we amending it in the E & R amendment?

SENATOR WESELY: Well, you're probably right. It's...

SENATOR HALL: And if the answer is it sunsets, that's fine, then if, and if we're exchanging the language that's in the...

SENATOR WESELY: Right.

SENATOR HALL: ...E & R amendments for the language that shows up as listed in Section 22,...

SENATOR WESELY: Right.
