

SENATOR LINDSAY: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Call of the house.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Senator Wesely has requested a call of the house. All those in favor of the house going under call vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.
