SENATOR MCKENZIE: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. Last but not least, the amendment you have on your desk, AM2489, delivered to us from fiscal this evening, based on the amendment that Senator Bromm, Bohlke, Bernard-Stevens and McKenzie proposed, the compromise amendment with the 2.5 and the 3, it incorporates those changes in the A bill, but it also then includes the \$80,000 that Senator Bohlke and Bromm had in their amendment that was pulled to provide additional funds to do the waivers at the state department. I'd answer any questions you have, if you have none, I would urge adoption of the amendment.
