SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We will now move to Item 9 on the agenda, Select File. Mr. Clerk, LB 371.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first item on 371 is consideration of Enrollment and Review amendments.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Maurstad on the E & R amendments.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I would move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 371.

SENATOR HALL: You've heard the motion. Is there any discussion? Seeing none, all in favor vote aye. Opposed. The E & R amendments are adopted. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next item I have is legislative amendment, AM0998, offered by Senator Withem.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Lindsay, you are recognized.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Mr. President. I guess, first, I want to, there has been some discussion up in the front of the Chamber, I would prefer us first getting the issue out before the body. I would ask the Chair to rule, I know there are some amendments to the committee amendments that have been filed, and there have been amendments to the bill that have been filed, and I would ask the Chair to rule, are we taking up the amendments to the bill first, or are we taking up the amendments to the committee amendments, which were adopted at General File, that we didn't get to because of cloture? I guess I would ask for a ruling from the Chair on the order that you intend to take those up.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. The Chair is going to rule that since we had, in this case, actually two sets of committee amendments; the first set which had amendments filed to it, and then, subsequently, when the bill was returned to committee, a second set of committee amendments which were adopted as the last act prior to advancing the bill over because the use of cloture with regard to the rules, that the amendments
