

SENATOR LINDSAY: Right, there is already a Section 41 in the bill.

SENATOR PIRSCH: So Section 41 in the bill is already excluded from this purview?

SENATOR LINDSAY: It will not be changed, right.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Okay, and so which ones are E & R sections that you want to do first? The operative section, 40. How do you know, how can you do the E & R before you know what you are going to adopt in there?

SENATOR LINDSAY: Well, they are, and I don't want to be misleading. These are not E & R in the sense of E & R amendments that we adopt...that Senator Maurstad had moved for and adopt, but as you know, at times E & R suggests better phrasing or change that they think should be included, but are not comfortable as being pure technical changes that might have some substance to them. Frankly, I am not sure what they change. When E & R suggests them, I assume that they are okay.

SENATOR PIRSCH: And you don't know what sections those are?

SENATOR LINDSAY: I do. Page 8, lines 2 to 4; page 18 and 19; page 8,...

SENATOR PIRSCH: Would you go slower please?

SENATOR LINDSAY: Sure.

SENATOR PIRSCH: On page 8, lines 2 and 4, 2 to 4 are E & R.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Well, let me back up and we will go through it.

SENATOR PIRSCH: But that talks about when the operative sections of 15, 16, 22, 28 to 39 and 42 of this, and we haven't changed 42 yet.

SENATOR LINDSAY: These came down. These E & R amendments came down and are valid or are assumed or needed to the bill, itself, without regard to whether we adopt or not adopt any thing in this amendment.
