

to line 27, you take all of line 27, and then all of page 9, and that is the balance of the first division. The second division is found on page 8 as well. It begins on line 9, it is all of line 9, 10 and 11, it runs through the semicolon on line 12, after the. That is the second division. Move to the page 1, you start on line 3, where it says Section 27, all through the balance of page 1, all of page 2, and you move to page 3 through line 8. That is the third division; so it's lines 3 on page 1, the balance of that page, all of page 2, and the first eight lines of page 3. The fourth division begins on line 9 of page 3, where it says Section 28, it's the balance of the page, all of page 4, all of page 5, all of page 6, all of page 7, and the first line of page 8, that is the fourth division. You've got that, we will move to the fifth division, which is found on page 8 and it is lines 7 and 8. The sixth division is found on page 8 and it is lines 14 and 15. The seventh division is found on page 8, and if you start on line 12 where we left off after the semicolon, you take the balance of line 12, then all of line 13, that is the seventh division. The eighth division is found on page 8, it begins on line 23 after the semicolon with reinstate, and it goes through the period on line 26; that's the eighth division. The ninth division is found on page 8, it is all of lines 16 and 17. Then we move back to page 1, lines 1 and 2, strike Section 9 is the tenth division. Section 16, the striking of Section 16 will be the eleventh division. Would anyone like to have that repeated? (Laughter) Senator Kristensen, Senator Beutler. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator, I am sorry, on page 8, lines 18 and 19, was that part of the E & R, what was that?

SENATOR HALL: Yes, it was.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Eighteen, 19, 20 and 21 in their entirety, well, actually 18 through 23, the semicolon after section fits into the E & R, the number one division. Senator Kristensen. Senator Lindsay's staff is presently spelling that out and going to list it for you, so the divisions can be listed, and then we are going to...Senator Lindsay, you are recognized to tell us, if you would, assign an alphabetical representation, A through K, to these 11 divisions, so that we can then use those for purposes of handling the division in the order that it is going to be taken up.
