SENATOR HALL: Senator Lindsay, if you will respond.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Lindsay, the first part of item one would be lines 2 through 6 on page 8, yes, 2 through 6 on page 8.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now, what we are doing there is separating out...first of all, does this bill have the emergency clause? I don't think so.

SENATOR LINDSAY: No, it doesn't, but there is some...there is change, the operative dates deals with the change from three months after the session, some January 1. So there is a gap and some of the operative dates are changing to try to make sure that that gap is closed correctly.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, so when it says the operative date of the act, that simply means three months after we've adjourned.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Effective...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: The operative date of the act.

SENATOR LINDSAY: No, the effective date means three months after we adjourn. The operative date is either the effective date, if that is what it says. Give an example, if you can look up on page 8, lines 2 through 4, you have...

SENATOR HALL: One minute.

SENATOR LINDSAY: ...Sections 15 , et cetera, become operative January 1 of '96. The other sections become operative on their effective date, which would be three months after...effective date is three months after the session.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, and the operative date is the date that's set which would differ from the effective date?

SENATOR LINDSAY: Right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, my time is out but my light is on. I might want to ask you about...
