

SENATOR HALL: Time.

SENATOR BROMM: I think it's a good policy question. That's the way I feel about it. Thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Senator Beutler, your light is next.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Hall, members of the Legislature, I support this portion of the amendment for reasons of logic. But what I wanted to do, Senator Lindsay, if I could, was to engage you in a discussion on another portion of your proposed amendment.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And the reason that I'm doing this is just to get some things on the record and to illustrate what I think is a problem with another section of the amendment, I'm sorry, not the amendment, of the E & R amendments,...

SENATOR LINDSAY: Uh-huh.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...because I'm fearful that I will not be able to amend or get to that particular section and I wanted to acquaint you with it and see if you thought somehow it could or should be dealt with. But the section I wanted to identify to you was on page 9 of the E & R amendments,...

SENATOR LINDSAY: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...and it has to do with the offense of committing the offense of unauthorized entry into a propelled vehicle.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And there are a number of aspects of that that are of interest to me but, just for openers, the penalty for that is a Class IV felony.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Right.
