So don't talk to me today about the children, that we've got to think of the children. What we're thinking of is the people up in Omaha that are going to make the money on selling that land, right? Think about that. Well, of course they are. They aren't going to give it away, they're going to make some money on it, if they possibly can. That's the American way, free enterprise, sell your land. All you ever have to remember, from a class in economics and Father Guido Sarducci, am I saying that correct? He said this, all you have to remember, supply and demand, you buy something for a price and you sell it for a higher price, right? Well, this is what we're talking about here is this land,...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR CROSBY: ...this is what we're talking about. And someone is offended because someone out west used the term economic development. Well, what is it in Omaha? It's going to cause and bring more people there because they'll have to come to see their children. Not every one of them will be living near that facility. So at the beginning I said I'm going to change my vote, but because of the things that I heard about the time line, not necessarily any of the other reasons, Jim, I think there probably is a point there that we do need to get going on it as soon as we can, whenever the powers that be in Omaha decide that they can work with corrections and decide where to put it and I hope can get the money to do it. But please don't talk to me about the children. You told me yesterday what you think of children. Thank you.
