

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. Would members please return to the floor. Members on the floor, please record your presence. Unauthorized individuals leave the floor. Senator Wesely, please check in. Senator Beutler, Senator Brashear, Senator Bromm, Senator Lindsay. Senator Robinson, Senator Matzke, Senator Stuhr, Senator Will, Senator Janssen, Senator Kristensen. Senator Matzke and Senator Will. We're still looking for Senator Matzke and Senator Will. Senator Chambers asked for a machine vote, as I recall, on his amendment. All in of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Mr. Clerk, record the vote, and Senator Chambers has asked for a record vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2553 of the Legislative Journal.) 8 ayes, 17 nays on the amendment to the amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment to the amendment is defeated. We are back to the Landis amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President,...

SPEAKER WITHEM: The call is raised, by the way.

CLERK: ...I have the next amendment, AM2515, that's offered by Senators Bromm, Beutler, and Lindsay. (See pages 2553-55 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: As an amendment...as an amendment to the Landis amendment. Senator Lindsay is opening.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members, this is what we've been trying to work on. Everything that's in here has been discussed on the floor in the last two and a half, three hours. Everything that's in here has been discussed. And I will pass on...I'm going to yield to Senators Beutler and Bromm to explain that. I should say that it's been with input from both Senators Bromm and Beutler and Senator Witek and several others, I guess, that stopped over. But, with that, to explain the amendment I'm going to yield to, I guess, Senator Beutler. I yield seven minutes, Mr. Speaker.
