

with Senator Kristensen about this matter we think that the Governor, when the appointments are made, we can find someone who will represent that interest on the commission. I hope that is done because all of the rest of the people here have, it seems to me, legitimate peripheral interest but we have a category of people, those people who have their property blocked and separated by railroads that also have a vital interest in seeing a resolution to the crossing problem. But I think we'll be able to accommodate their interests without a specific amendment. So I've chosen not to bring that, but I hope you will support Senator Withem's initiative.

The question before the body is the motion to return LB 265 to Select File. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Senator Withem.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Rather pointless because we're going to run out of time anyway, but I would...I would request a roll call vote on the motion to return.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Do you want a call of the house?

SPEAKER WITHEM: I believe we should be under call.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: You're on Final Reading. Senators, check in, please. There's been a request for a roll call vote. Will senators please check in. Senator Pedersen, check in, please. Senator Wehrbein, Senator Wesely, Senator Fisher. Senator Withem, check in, please. Senator Beutler, check in, please. Mr. Clerk, please proceed.
