PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Day. Senator Elmer.

SENATOR ELMER: Thank you, Madam President. I've had a number of calls from our nursing homes out in my district regarding this, and they are claiming that it would be very hard to get the staffing that they need to operate their nursing homes. Is what you are doing here going to address that problem?

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, we delay the implementation, and it is not the language in the bill so much, as how it is interpreted that's the problem. So this way we see the rules and regs, and if they don't come out the way we need, then we can make the changes. We think it will be fine, and the nursing homes have signed off on this, so...

SENATOR ELMER: Okay, thank you, Senator Wesely.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Wehrbein. Is there any further discussion on the motion to return to Select File. Seeing none, Senator Wesely to close. Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the motion to return LB 563E to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 563E returns to Select File. The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely to open on his amendment.

SENATOR WESELY: Again, this is the amendment that delays the two sections that were in controversy for a year so we can see the rules and regs before they go into effect. I would ask for your support. Thank you.
