LB 241, 658, 887

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 241 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 241 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2573-74 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 241 passes with the emergency clause attached. We now turn to Item 8 on our agenda and LB 887.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 887 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 887 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2574 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 42 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 658 (sic) (LB 887) passes with the emergency clause attached. We now turn to item 9 on the agenda, Select File, and LB 658.

CLERK: Madam President, with respect to LB 658, I had, or I should say the Legislature discussed the issue on April 21 and again on May 8. Senator Pedersen has an amendment that was adopted. Senator Bohlke had offered AM2385. The bill was eventually bracketed. Senator Bohlke, I now have AM2385 in front of me. Senator, it is my understanding you would like to withdraw 2385 and offer in lieu thereof AM2499?

SENATOR BOHLKE: That is correct.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any objection? Seeing none, it is so ordered.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Bohlke would offer AM2499. (See pages 2543 of the Legislative Journal.) Senator, do you
