

SENATOR BOHLKE: Right ahead of it, on line 12...on line 7, I'm sorry, Senator Abboud. Each school district shall provide annually to the State Department of Education.

SENATOR ABOUD: What about providing this information to the federal government?

SENATOR BOHLKE: We don't...we don't have that requirement in here, but the state department...it's outlined to them that they have to do that.

SENATOR ABOUD: Where is that? Are we just going to hope that they do it? I mean, I'm not being facetious, I mean, shouldn't that also be part of the bill that this information be provided to the federal government? If we require the school boards to provide the information to the department, State Department of Education, shouldn't we also require that the State Department of Education provide this to the federal government as well?

SENATOR LINDSAY: One minute.

SENATOR ABOUD: If it's a part of the federal rules and regulations?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Senator Abboud, I guess the reason I keep looking at it is I'm just thinking at it differently, the federal government does require it of the State Department of Education and so you're saying, you know...so I don't see why we would need to do that.

SENATOR ABOUD: Okay, well, maybe what I'll do is I'll go to you off the floor and then I'll talk to Senator Beutler concerning the rules and regs about that.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Okay, right.

SENATOR ABOUD: Thank you.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Senator Abboud. Senator Elmer.

SENATOR ELMER: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. Would Senator Beutler yield to a question, please?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes.
