CLERK: LB 658A, Senator, the Enrollment and Review amendments have been adopted. Senator Bohlke would move to amend. AM2548. (See page 2605 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Madam President and members, you remember that last time we discussed this we...Senator Warner raised the question of actually having an amount in, the expenditure. That amount is \$4,021 in order to do the rules and regs on the gun-free schools. With that, I ask for your adoption.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the opening on Senator Bohlke's amendment to 658A. Any discussion? Seeing none, Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BOHLKE: One...one correction, really the rules and regs are for the alternative schools in the gun-free schools so...but that's my close, thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the Bohlke amendment to 658A. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Bohlke's amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to advance LB 658A to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance to E & R Engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. LB 860A.

CLERK: LB 860A, Madam President, introduced by Senator Wehrbein. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on May 17 of this year.
