CLERK: Senator Withem, I had a...I have nothing further on that bill, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Before we proceed to LB 209, Senator Maurstad has a guest under the...today, Mrs. Hansen, Mrs. Linda Hansen from Papillion, and she is the mother of Senator Maurstad's legislative aide. Would you please stand and be welcomed by the Legislature. Thank you. Item 8, Select File, LB 209. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 209, the first item, Senator Maurstad, E & R amendments, Senator.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I would move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 209.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are...they are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Preister would move to amend. AM1948, Senator. It's on page 1964 of the Journal.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Preister.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Honorable President, friends all. This is an amendment that we passed over when we were on the bill on General File. It's an amendment that has a section that now would not be appropriate. I have redrafted a different amendment deleting a section that I believe Senator Schrock is going to be addressing. That is AM2368. I would ask for unanimous consent to substitute this amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Any objections to substituting the amendment? Seeing none, it is substituted.

CLERK: Senator, just so...2368, is that the one you want?

SENATOR PREISTER: Yes, 2368.

CLERK: Okay, thank you.
