

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Preister. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Preister, if I might, let me just ask you what your intent is with...on this amendment with respect to...

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Preister, will you yield for a question?

SENATOR PREISTER: Yes, I will.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...with respect to existing controlled shooting areas. You know, right now there are certain areas of land around the state, as you are well aware, that are already establish controlled shooting areas. And under this bill we're going to...we will establish two different categories, private and commercial. And some of these new private categories may be established out of...cut out of existing controlled area, as you are well aware. Others of these new private places may be just new applications to bring new land into this controlled shooting area concept under the category of private shooting areas. Your amendment, as it's currently drafted, let's talk about three categories. Would it affect current...currently licensed commercial shooting areas? Would it affect them...

SENATOR PREISTER: I believe that...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...in their renewal processes or would it in any way affect them?

SENATOR PREISTER: I believe that it probably would, Senator Beutler, although I'm not positive of that.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Is it your intent to affect them?

SENATOR PREISTER: They wouldn't be affected currently. I think it would come into play when they renew their license and at that particular time then the configuration would be affected.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And with respect to the new private areas, to the extent that they were carved out of existing control areas, the same would be true of them, I guess. That would be your intent?

SENATOR PREISTER: That would be...the way it's worded now, I
