SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, Senator Hudkins, would you like to finish your response?

SENATOR HUDKINS: Thank you, Senator Chambers. I was going to say that Game and Parks has said that this will cause a lot more problems than it is going to...it's going to cause more problems than it would have fixed because the result was, with this shall, was that Game and Parks would have to revoke a license on a very, very minor infraction.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, is it better to say change the may to shall, or to scale the violations and make them knowing and intentional? Because Senator Schrock's amendment carries us back to page 25, where we deal with any violation that occurs in Section 37-901, and that's where we begin, on page 25. And it puts in a lot of these requirements that I guess we're supposed to reassure people about the tightness of the regulations of this activity. So they could violate those provisions in 37-901, and if they're a big shot, or for whatever reason, their license wouldn't have to be revoked, would it, if you put may?

SENATOR HUDKINS: Game and Parks has to investigate any violation that is reported to them. Having the may in there lets them decide that this is in fact a very minor violation, we will get the violation corrected and they may continue to operate on their license. But if you have the word shall in there any violation is going to shut them down. These controlled shooting areas are a very large investment, and to shut someone down on a very small violation, in my opinion, is not fair. But the word may in there says after investigation if the violation is not corrected or they refuse to correct it, we still can take their license away.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Hudkins, and, Senator Schrock, don't be offended that I'm asking her these questions, but it's her bill, what would be deemed a minor violation by those who wanted this bill?

SENATOR HUDKINS: You would have to ask Game and Parks that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, Senator Schrock said he's willing to answer, Senator Hudkins, so I would ask Senator Schrock that question.
