

now, and so these folks aren't just dreaming up what might be a problem in the future but these folks are already experiencing a controlled shooting area. They know already the number of people that are out there doing the shooting and I'll say it when Senator Stuhr is here but deal a little bit more with the numbers of people who actually do frequent these areas. The concern is for those folks not just dreaming up what may be a problem, but they're living with the problem. They're seeing the animals that are driven out of the area out onto the highway and being hit by cars. They're seeing the fact that there is an endangerment of the people in the area. They're seeing the wildlife driven on to their adjoining property lands and they're seeing the potential danger that that causes with traffic accidents as well as with the hunters who have nothing to do with the controlled shooting area and those hunters who happen to be driving by when it is hunting season and who road hunt. There are those among us who wouldn't necessarily consider somebody who broke the law like that as a true hunter, however, there are people who have a gun and, because this area is immediately adjoining Omaha and in a growth area where there's going to be more development, that these folks are seeing an existing problem that's only going to get worse and they're coming to us and they're saying we would like you to listen to this and we would like you to not craft laws that make life more uncomfortable for us but they would like to see us make it easier for them to enjoy their homes and they would like to see that their families are not put in greater danger. They would like to see less risk of rifle shots and I recognize that certainly it's illegal for people to be shooting into homes, however, when you're talking about areas where Game and Parks commissioners and people who control and regulate and enforce the laws that we have are not able to be in those areas and where those people don't have the opportunity to even be available, we're not just talking about existing laws, we're talking about enforcement of those existing laws and those laws aren't able to be enforced when you don't have the people power to be able to be out there and to do it, and that seems to be the case. At least it's the case that appears to the folks living in the area who are being influenced and impacted by this existing controlled shooting area and if that is expanded and more people are brought in we're not just talking about those people who pay to come there to hunt but, according to the people that are living in the area there and I haven't validated this but other people who are not neighbors have told me that there is an airport, a landing strip that's been put in on the
