

area of land and not for several pieces of land that are broken up with areas or space in between. The third requirement is that the area has the proper requirements for operation as a controlled shooting area. Those requirements then are referenced back to a number of statutes, all of which pertain to controlled shooting areas, and refer to such things, for example, as the requirement that there be a certain minimum number of birds that are released on each one of these controlled shooting areas annually and there is a requirement, for example, that there be a report filed every year with respect to the number of birds released and the number of birds taken and from those records Game and Parks is supposed to be able to determine whether the controlled shooting area is being run in accordance with those particular rules. However, at least with respect to a few of the controlled shooting areas, the reporting has been chronically deficient and that has led to the discussion which you heard earlier between "may" and "shall" with respect to the revocation of a license. If failure to properly report on the number of birds released and the number of birds harvested was a...was a absolute...was a cause that required the revocation of a license...

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ..you would probably see several controlled shooting areas in the state that would shortly no longer have a license. How do you encourage people to keep these sorts of records so that Game and Parks can properly see how they're running the operation short of...short of requiring that the license be revoked? I think it's fortunate that we did revoke that "shall", did withdraw or amend the "shall revoke" language because Game and Parks does need additional flexibility. On the other hand, I think Game and Parks needs to have better communication with these people and make it clear to them that they really are interested in seeing that the rules are followed and there really will be additional measures taken if the inability to report correctly becomes chronic as it has been in the past. And I didn't get all the way through this, Mr. Chairman, but I think I said as much as people are interested in hearing and I hope the amendment is about ready.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Time. Is there any further discussion on the Preister amendment 2409? Senator Beutler, you're recognized for your third time on this amendment.
