

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, as I understand the status of negotiations, we're down to one word here and I'm going to talk a little bit longer as that one word is discussed and hopefully a compromise amendment will be before you shortly. But I was describing for you the different criteria that need to be reviewed by Game and Parks on these applications for controlled shooting areas and I had just described for you the fact that the game birds propagated or released on the area needed to meet all the requirements of operation with respect to the controlled shooting area. It also says that the game birds propagated or released on the area are not likely to be diseased or a menace to other game. I don't know what all Game and Parks does in that particular area to see that...that that criteria is met. I assume that they do have a set of criteria and I assume that the criteria has something to do with the number of birds involved and the way that they're housed and the manner in which they're dealt with because that certainly would have a significant effect on the likelihood of the birds being diseased. I'm sure the source of acquisition for the birds would be a factor in considering whether the birds were likely to be diseased, the type of bird and a number of...and a number of other factors. Another factor and, as you can see by now, there are several factors that we have already identified as factors that we definitely want to see reviewed in establishing these areas. Another factor is that the operation of the controlled area will not work as a fraud upon persons who may be permitted to hunt on the area. Now that's a factor upon which we've had no discussion in the Natural Resources Committee since I've been on the committee and I assume...well, I'm not really sure what that has reference to. If anybody knows what that has reference to, Senator Schrock, do you know what that has reference to? Senator Schrock, weren't you listening? Okay. (Laugh) Well, it says here that with regard to the criteria to be considered in the application...on the application for license that they will consider whether the operation of the area will not work as a fraud upon persons who may be permitted to hunt on the area. Does that mean bringing persons in to hunt when you haven't released any birds or what does that mean? Senator Schrock would like to reply to this,...

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Schrock.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ..Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, if you advertised that you had a
