

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Preister, do you want this for speaking or for closing?

SENATOR PREISTER: For speaking.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Okay.

SENATOR PREISTER: And it may not take all the time and then I may not have a closing, but I would just like to have on the record a couple of questions of both Senator Schrock and of Senator Hudkins and my question is we are inserting substantially and we're talking about substantial harm and I guess I would like to have a little bit of discussion on what that entails when we're talking about what constitutes substantial harm or potential harm to the adjoining landowners and if anyone else, Senator Beutler, feel free too, but if anyone else would like to comment on that I think that substantial is something that I am willing to put in and it does add clarity and again, in the interest of what we're about and the other bills that are being held up by this, I want to be sure that what we're doing does deal with the issue and I appreciate also Senator Hudkins and Senator Schrock and particularly Senator Beutler working to come up with this language that, as we've all said, is not in full accord or agreement to all of us but which we have before us. Senator Hudkins, if you could give me your definition, and I know we really didn't get into it that much, but when we...when we're talking about substantial...creating a substantial threat, what...what would you envision that that substantial threat would be as we're looking at this? And that's just to get something on the record so that we have that.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Hudkins.

SENATOR HUDKINS: Thank you, Senator Preister. Really, I'm not the person to be asking because that language is directed toward Game and Parks and it will be up to them to decide what substantial harm is, taking into consideration the public's input in that public hearing.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Senator Hudkins. And I think Game and Parks does have much leeway with the way this is drafted and as they did before and they will continue to have that leeway, but I think it's also important to know that Game and Parks
