

easy when you consider how these operations function to tell when something is accidental, but as we all agree out in the hallway, if the same act is repeated over and over and becomes a pattern the person could not say this is accidental. There'd be enough evidence to show that the pattern established that it wasn't. But any of these things which were done accidentally or through inadvertence could not be used as a basis to revoke somebody's license under this language.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Now if they had some city slickers out there that didn't quite know what they were doing and they released some cattle instead of some birds, that would be a violation?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, that's intentional. Even city slickers have to know the difference between a cow and a bird, unless it's a cowbird.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Thank you. That concludes my remarks.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Senator Chambers, there would be no further lights on. Recognize you to close. And he waives closing. The question is, shall the Chambers amendment be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: The amendment is adopted. Are there any other amendments?

CLERK: Senator Hudkins, I assume you don't want your motion? I have nothing further on the bill at this time, Mr. President.
