SENATOR SCHMITT: I think some of them are, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR SCHMITT: And I had my light on, I was going to ask you some questions there, too, so I'll wait until I get my light on and go ahead and answer that on my own time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, but I had to clear that up right away. People are on the floor talking about things that they don't even understand and don't know and the Patrol will do things that are not truthful. When I stopped on the highway and there was some discussion about it,...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: The troopers at the highway scene, they lied, they lied about what happened and how long it took. But you know what I told the colonel, and you can talk to him about it, I said they had their little mike activated and they had the camera on in the car, so you check how much time it took from the time I arrived to the time it was over. And he found out that the troopers had not told the truth. And I also said if their mike was...their little thing was activated and they picked up what I said, they had to pick up what the trooper said, too. So check that out, and the story changed. He acknowledged that they had too many troopers there, including some dog wagons. So troopers on the scene don't always tell the truth and I know that to be a fact. I'm trying to put some language in this legislation which is reasonable. But whether you put it there or not, in the same way that a human officer can be convicted of excessive force, these dogs can be found to have exceeded what they should have done and a person would have a cause of action.
