SENATOR CHAMBERS: And I'm not saying they intentionally do it. I say you're giving carte blanche where it shouldn't be given.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I do not...I do not have a good count of how many other entities besides the State Patrol have it, but...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...I will consider your offer very seriously. Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: We have to do it while we're on Select File and we have to do it today.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Right. So you want me to make an instant decision. I need...
