SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS PRESIDING

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: The amendment is agreed to. Anything else on the desk? The call is raised.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President, at this time.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Is there any discussion on the advancement of LB 283? Seeing none at this point, the Chair recognizes Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I would move to advance LB 283 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: All those in favor say aye; opposed nay. The ayes have it, the ayes do have it, the bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.
