

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Fisher, Senator Bernard-Stevens, Senator Witek, Senator Cudaback, Senator Janssen, Senator Schimek, Senator Withem, Senator Brashear, Senator Robinson, Senator Matzke, Senator Schrock, Senator Chambers, Senator Stuhr, Senator Lynch, Senator Beutler, Senator Lindsay, and Senator Will.

CLERK: Senator Landis voting no. Senator McKenzie voting yes. Senator Will voting yes. Senator Maurstad voting yes. Senator Janssen voting yes.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 11 nays on the advancement of LB 344.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 344 advances. We are now on Final Reading. Excuse me, we have 15 minutes to work on LB 365. I raise the call.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Maurstad, E & R amendments to 365, first of all, Senator.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 365.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, the question before the body is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 365. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. The amendments are adopted.
