

there are no further lights. The Chair recognizes Senator Warner to close on his amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Just briefly, Madam President, the other thing I do think that this, addition of this amendment will encourage negotiations in each of these areas in their entirety, and not get hung up on one isolated issue that might have gone to the special master when the entire issue of wages, if that was the section, ought to be considered. With that, I'd urge the body adopt the amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Warner. The question before the body is the adoption of the Warner amendment to LB 365. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Warner amendment is adopted. Is there anything further?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to advance LB 365 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Wehrbein.
