PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Pedersen. The question before the body is the motion to return LB 275 to Select File for specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 275 returns to Select File. Senator Pedersen, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR PEDERSEN: Madam President, members of the Legislature, I would just give you some time, if you have any questions to ask. I think it has already been explained, and anything more I would be glad to help you with. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Pedersen. Any discussion of the Pedersen amendment? Seeing none, Senator Pedersen to close. Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the Pedersen amendment to LB 275. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Pedersen amendment is adopted. Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to advance LB 275 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion. Seeing none, the question before the body is the advancement of LB 275. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. LB 275 advances.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Bernard-Stevens would move to suspend the germaneness rule so as to permit consideration of an amendment filed at the desk in conjunction with the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Bernard-Stevens to open on his motion.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Madam President, and
