

for example your address is 217 South Hull and you sign it as 217 and you put S. Hull, does that match? Well the legal concept of substantial compliance probably says that it does. And so for those areas that are very, very close you're covered anyway, but I'm afraid if you put in the words "substantially compares with" you begin to get, well it's in the neighborhood, it's within the ballpark. Those are very dangerous terms to begin to interject in here because you're going to have different interpretations and you should stick with the legal standard and just because you see the word "compare" on page 7, I'd go over and look on page 6, there's the word "street", there's the word "together", we could use some of those words because they appear somewhere else. It doesn't make any sense. It's very dangerous and when you begin to create new legal standards, you're going to create legal problems that really you'd never dreamed of and quite frankly, are going to cause greater problems and for those of you who are so concerned about the rights of petitions, you ought to be scared to death to start changing legal standards in the middle of the stream. I think that it would be wise to defeat this amendment. I don't know what else is up there, but if they're like this, I doubt there would be a lot of favor with them and then probably shouldn't be. Thank you.
