PRESIDENT ROBAK: The balance of the Lindsay amendment is adopted. We now take a vote on the Landis amendment. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. There has been a request for a roll call vote. And the question before you is the adoption of the Landis amendment, Mr. Clerk, please proceed.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2660 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 5 nays on adoption of Senator Landis's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Landis amendment is adopted. We now turn to a vote on the advancement of LB 371. There has been a request for a roll call vote. The question before you is the advancement of LB 371 to Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, please proceed with the roll call vote in reverse order.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken in reverse order. See pages 2660-61 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 5 nays on the advancement.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 371 advances. I raise the call. We turn now to Item 6 on the agenda and LB 371A.

CLERK: Madam President, 371A. (Read title.) Senator Lindsay had an amendment. Senator, I know you want to withdraw AM2374.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Lindsay would move to indefinitely postpone LB 371A.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Madam President and members. We've had discussions with the department, as far as the fiscal note on this would have been \$25,000 for the coming fiscal year. Because we delayed some of the operative date, the 25,000 won't be necessary. The department has indicated that they can absorb that cost, so the fiscal note to this extent would not be necessary. They've indicated also in the out...in the second year of the biennium, the cost would be about 170,000, they've indicated they can either absorb that cost or they would come back in for a deficit appropriation.
