SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Senator Withem, were you finished. Senator Schrock, did you have your light on for...we will continue...we will proceed to Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, did you have any items for the record or anything ahead of that. Final Reading, LB 19E.

CLERK: (Began reading LB 19E on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Withem. Senator Withem.

SPEAKER WITHEM: I am sorry. I apologize, Mr. Clerk, for that. The bill, that has the E clause, we don't have 33 people here. I would suggest dropping this bill down to say after LB 3...well, hold on. I would suggest dropping this...what would be the next bill after 19E.

CLERK: LB 189.

SPEAKER WITHEM: That also has the E clause. So what would be the next bill?

CLERK: LB 376, 377.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Let's go to 376, probably...

CLERK: Mr. President, Mr. Speaker, LB 574 is a long bill, if that makes a difference to you.
