

cooperation, as one senator might describe their activity, and despite the recalcitrant of the Bar Association, as another senator might characterize what happened, there might be some kind of consensus, which I call nonsense, that this bill should be enacted into law. I don't think that it should and I am going to vote against it. But in trying to have these specific items considered, I don't intent to use every tactic under the rules available to extend the debate. So since we are on Final Reading, I would ask that we check in. Again I will accept a machine vote, but I want it to be a record vote.
