PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 430 pass? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2673-74 of the Legislative Journal.) 32 ayes, 11 nays, 2 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 430 passes. LB 494.

CLERK: (Read LB 494 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 494 pass? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.
