We've been asked to reconsider this and I do find that a little appalling when, frankly, there are people here on the floor who are being attentive and then to be drawn back into the same discussion again because there were people who were somewhere else. And, yes, I go to the lounge too, occasionally, but just because you're in the lounge and then come back just to say that I think now we need to reconsider this because I wasn't here is a little unfair to those people who have spent the time, who have listened to the discussion and so I would ask that we move on, that we not reconsider this anymore and let's get back to the bill. We've got a lot of work ahead of us. I would like to see us do that. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Witek. Senator Witek has called the question. All those...do I see five hands? I do. The question before the body is, shall debate now cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all...record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Debate has ceased. Senator Wesely. Senator Wesely withdraws the motion. Visited with some of the individuals involved with this bill and we will be passing over this bill for 30 minutes. There seems to be some discussion going on but we do not have time for the body to stand still while that negotiation goes on. As close to six forty-five, excuse me, six fifteen as is possible, we will conclude whatever bill we're on and then six twenty-six we'll be back on the agenda. Mr. Clerk, the next item, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 646 on Final Reading. I do have motions with respect to this bill. The first is by Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers would move to return the bill for a specific amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Chambers. Anything else on the bill while we're waiting to see if Senator Chambers is in the neighborhood?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Witek would move to return. Senator Witek, I have two amendments, AM1677, you want to withdraw, Senator.
