Schmidt for sitting through this, Ed Russo for the Lincoln Journal, Bill Hord of the Omaha World-Herald, our two camera persons from NETV, all of the Pages, and the spectators, the state trooper, those in the balcony, and everybody within the sound of my voice, I want to thank all of you for something or other.
