CLERK: (Read LR 3CA on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LR 3CA pass? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Madam President, I would like everybody to check in please, and I would like a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator. There has been a request that senators check in. Will you all check in please. Senator Bernard-Stevens. Senator Kristensen, will you check in please. Senator Bromm, Senator Avery. Senator Withem, will you check in please. Senator Landis. Senator Elmer, will you check in please. Senator Beutler, will you check in please. Waiting for Senator Bernard-Stevens. Senator Kristensen, will you check in please. We are waiting for Senator Bernard-Stevens. Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Madam President, I think it is okay for Senator Bernard-Stevens if he'd..want to check in, I think that would be fine.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: There has been a request for a roll call vote. The question before you is the passage of LB, excuse me, LR 3CA. There needs to be 40 votes to pass the bill for a special election. Mr. Clerk, please proceed.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2689 of the Legislative Journal.) 37 ayes, 6 nays.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: We now return to a vote on LR 3CA. The question...excuse me. Mr. Clerk, there is a motion on the floor.

CLERK: Senator Withem would move to reconsider the vote just taken.
