

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 642, a bill introduced by Senator Avery. (Read title.) The bill was discussed on May 9 of this year. When we left the bill, I believe, Mr. President, there was pending Senator Hillman, Schimek, Day had a motion to bracket the bill. I have a note that you'd like to withdraw that now, Senator.

SPEAKER WITHEM: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Then, Mr. President, prior to the bracket motion Senator Avery had an amendment, AM1575, that had been divided. Senator Schimek had moved to amend... Oh, I'm sorry. Senator Schimek has adopted an amendment to the first part of that amendment, I believe. And the first amendment I have pending to the Avery amendment, the divided Avery amendment is by Senator Hall. Senator Hall is excused, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Pass over the amendment.

CLERK: Senator Schimek, you now have the next amendment to Senator Avery's amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: It is withdrawn. Senator Avery is making a request to withdraw his divided amendment. I believe as it was divided that needs to be through unanimous consent. Is there an objection? So ordered. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: The next amendment, Senator Bernard-Stevens and Day, but I have a note you want to withdraw that.

SPEAKER WITHEM: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: At least I have a note from Senator Bernard-Stevens. Okay. Senator Lindsay, Hall, Kristensen, Chambers and Abboud.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Are any of those individuals prepared to take up the amendment? We'll pass over it. Okay, Senator Chambers is one of the introducers, indicates it is to be withdrawn, so ordered.

CLERK: Senator Avery, 2293, Senator. (Found on page 2313 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR AVERY: Yes, that's the one I would like to take up.
