LB 642, 642A

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 642 advances. LB 642A. Senator Avery, to open.

SENATOR AVERY: All right, this is the A bill. Of course, I would hope this would follow and we maintain this, keep it along with the bill. As I had stated before, in terms of just the initial process of creating FTEs and deleting FTEs and working with foster care, there is dollars there, there showed about a \$10,000 savings, and that includes about 14,000 foster or that DSS has said they would need because of this process. In terms of long-range, I think we have to give this process a chance to work through the pilot projects and make sure the savings. The bottom line is we'll have a better product and I would hope you could support and move the A bill along. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the opening. There are no lights on. Closing, Senator Avery? Closing is waived. Question is the advancement of LB 642A. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.
