Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the amendment,
Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. Speaker, I would move to advance LB 296
to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye.
Opposed. It is advanced. We're...LB 344 is a fairly lengthy
bill. We're going to pass over that bill and move to...well,
no, we're going to move back to LB 296, I guess. I was getting
ahead of myself. We'll do 296. We'll then pass over 344, and
then do 365. Let's do LB 365. LB 365 we'll go to.

CLERK: (Read LB 365 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All procedures relative to procedure having
been complied with, the question is, shall LB 365 pass? All
those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Senator Abboud.

SENATOR ABBOUD: Mr. President, I would ask for everyone to
check in and do a roll call vote.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Every...we are on Final Reading. Members are
to be in their seats. We've had a request for all members to
check in. Please do so. While we're doing that, let me
announce that while the Legislature is in session and capable of
transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 871,
LB 99, LB 369, LB 369A, LB 384, LB 399, LB 386, LB 505, LB 530,
LB 693A, LB 265, LB 275, LB 275A and LB 283. Members, please
check in. Check and see if you have recorded your presence.
Senator Jones, Senator Stuhr. Senator Engel, could you check
in, please. Senator Lynch, Senator Brashear and Senator
Wickersham. We're waiting for Senator Wickersham. Senator
Abboud has requested that the roll call take place in regular
order. Mr. Clerk.
