I think we're just doing something a little too fast and I would simply ask you to postpone the enactment of this law until next session and take a look at all the facts in the meantime. Appreciate your patience.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. The question before you is the motion to bracket LB 860. Thank you, Senator Robinson. Will all the senators please check in. Thank you. There's been a request for a roll call vote. Senator Bohlke, Senator Abboud, Senator Kristensen, Senator Bromm, Senator Avery, Senator Withem, Senator Schimek, Senator Landis, Senator Pirsch. Senator Wickersham, Senator Lynch and Senator Wesely. We're waiting for Senator Landis. Thank you, Senator. Thank you Senator Robinson. The question before you is the motion to bracket LB 860. There's been a request for a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, please proceed.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2729-30 of the Legislative Journal.) 14 ayes, 32 nays on the motion to bracket.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The motion to bracket fails.

CLERK: May I read some items, Madam President?

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Yes, Mr. Clerk.
