

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR ROBINSON: But there are subsequent priorities and it can be for networking, additional equipment and any schools that have not done that, for example, Senator Robak, we checked on...I think, Fullerton is the school you're concerned about, they have it networked. Millard, we checked, and their two large high schools have not been networked.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator, could you answer the question, please.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Go ahead.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The question is, is it your intent that schools who already have direct networks should not be reimbursed for the cost of those networks? That's all I'm asking.

SENATOR ROBINSON: They will not be...they will...under this bill, they will not be, but they will be eligible for further networking, further hookups if they haven't hooked up...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...with them,...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...and further modems, and so forth.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, thank you. Then we...

SENATOR ROBINSON: Let me add one more thing.

SENATOR BEUTLER: No, no, not on my time, Senator.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Wait, wait just a minute. Okay.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator, I just want to use the rest of my time, please. I understand what you said. You said they are not...they do not have the right to reimbursement. You said if it gets to the second priority, they might, if they have future expenditures there, be reimbursed. But let me tell you, with
